Welcome From your Officers and Board of Directors



Coaches, Athletes, Parents and Family Members:

The 2015 Washington Youth Education in Shooting Sports (WAYESS) State Championship shoot in Spokane is fast approaching.

Our state organization has gone through a name change but it is basically a change in name only. Our goals remain the same. Our program continues to grow, due to the hard work of our coaches and volunteers. We have also grown financially. The endowment funds of our teams collectively total over one and one half million dollars. This is also due to the financial support we continue to receive from the Midway Foundation Inc. Funds distributed to our state teams totaled close to \$300,000 just last year.



Endowment funding has changed this year. In previous years our state organization received a lump sum of funds early in the year. This year we will not receive our funds until June or July. This allows Midway Foundations to have a better understanding of the number of teams in the program and to allocate the funds accordingly. Because of this we are not in a position to state how much we will have for endowment funding prior to the shoot.

We would request that you get registered as quickly as you can so that you don't miss the opportunity to participate in this event. We have really tight time frames for getting teams registered.

The registration deadline is April 17th, 2015 along with a \$40.00 deposit for each participant.

So please make sure to get your teams registered early! To keep you informed on the registration process once a registration is received we will post the team name on the wayess.org website. Any team registering past the deadline with the state will incur a \$30 late fee.

We look forward to seeing you all at the state shoot! We can make new friends, break some targets and have a good time watching the athletes gain experience and make new friendships at this wonderful event. DRESS CODE

TOPS – The sleeves must be at least four (4) inches long. Items of clothing that expose any part of the torso are prohibited. These include, but are not limited to, cutoff Tshirts, halter tops, tank tops, etc.

BOTTOMS – Shorts may not be more than five (5) inches above the knee. Short shorts and low riding shorts or pants revealing undergarments or buttocks are prohibited. Shorts and slacks must be worn at the waist.

CLOTHING ADORNMENTS

Shirts, hats, pants – any clothing – and any other associated items such as shooting bags or gear with pictures, caricatures, designs,

messages, writings, or other embellishments with direct or indirect references to alcohol, tobacco, sex or sexual connotations, drugs, gambling or profanities are prohibited. Camouflage attire is also prohibited.

SHOES

Shoes must be closed toe and have full backs. Flip-Flops and sandals are not allowed.

HATS

Hats must be worn with the bill of the hat in the front unless it interferes with the competitors shot. If that is the case the hat may be turned around for the shot and returned to the forward position immediately after the station is completed.
