LOCATION: Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park, Chugiak Alaska

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all competitors born in 1999 or later. All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting before competing in these events. A USA Shooting membership must be purchased or renewed prior to the State Junior Olympics match.

- RESIDENCE:** Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residency is defined as where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license or, if not licensed, where the competitor's parents/guardians reside. A shooter may compete as a non-resident in a state JO to qualify for the National Junior Olympic Championships; however, he or she will not be eligible for state awards. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Non-residents may compete for automatic invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Only U.S. citizens will be eligible for medals at State and National levels.
- ENTRY:** Athletes may shoot in more than one state championship, but only the scores from the first state match will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS. State hosts must be notified by the shooter prior to the match if they have already competed in a state championship. Juniors from states which are not holding a State JO and those who cannot attend their own State JO will be allowed to enter the non-resident division in another state. At entry, non-resident juniors must declare that they are shooting for a non-resident invitation.
- CATEGORIES:** The following categories will be used for individual competition:
J1- age 18-20, competitors born from 1999-2001
J2- age 15-17, competitors born from 2002-2004
J3- age 14 & under, competitors born in 2005 or later.
- RULES:** 2019 USA Shooting Rules will govern this shoot.
- COURSE OF FIRE:** 125 targets for trap, 125 targets for skeet.
- TARGETS:** All targets will be set to approximate international targets in accordance with USOC guidelines.
- AMMUNITION:** Only factory ammunition is allowed. All athletes will be required to shoot 24-gm (7/8oz) or 28-gm (1oz) loads.
- COACHING:** Coaching will NOT be permitted on shooting stations. No one other than competitors and shoot officials will be allowed forward of the "Bull rails".
- CONDUCT:** All participants and witnesses will be expected to conduct themselves in an orderly non-confrontational manner. Anyone who disturbs the peace and harmony of the shoot will be asked to leave or will be escorted off the shooting grounds. No exceptions.
- TIES:** All ties will be broken in accordance with ISSF Shooting Rules.
- FINALS:** Finals will be used to determine state category medals only. Finals will not be used to determine State JO winners or invitations to the NJOSC. Only AK residents may compete in the finals.

PARTICIPANT PINS: Junior Olympic participation pins will be provided by USA Shooting to each competitor (not each event).

AWARDS: USA Shooting will provide gold, silver and bronze medals for the first, second and third place resident male and female individuals in each event.

NJOSC Invitations: Competitors will be eligible for invitations to the National JO, provided that Trap entrants achieve a minimum score of 80. An invitation will be given to anyone who competes in the Skeet State JO match.

ENTRY FEES: **\$70 each (Skeet or Wobble Trap)** includes a USA Shooting fee of \$12.00 per individual for each event.

*This does **not** include the required USAS membership which should be paid by the member **before the event.***

Fees may be paid by mail (checks only) or at registration. Checks should be made payable to Birchwood Bears 4-H.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Advance entries will close COB **April 17th 2019**. Entries from all state residents received by that date will be accepted to range capacity. Every effort will be made to accept all non-resident competitors who enter before closing.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries made after the advance deadline will be accepted up to one hour before the start of shooting, subject to range capacity and at the discretion of shoot management. A late entry fee of \$10.00 will be charged.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations received one week in advance (COB April 12), or earlier, will receive a full refund.

NJOSC INVITATION PROCESS FOR 2019

In order to ensure we have space for all competitors, USAS is requiring a minimum cut-off score of 80 to qualify in TRAP at a State JO match. An automatic invitation will be given to anyone who competes in State JO SKEET matches.

USAS will also have open slots that are available to anyone who has hit the required cut-off score for Trap. These slots will be filled on a first-come first-served basis, with registration done via Sport:80 (USAS' online registration program). Registration opening and closing dates will be announced under the National Junior Olympic Program tab in plenty of time for shooters to sign up. This will allow for fast, efficient and effective communication to take place with all those interested in attending.

Beyond the open slots, a waiting list will be formed for those who did not qualify in any of the above processes. The waiting list also will be a first-come first-served signup process as well.

NOTE: THIS YEAR THE MINIMUM TRAP QUALIFICATION SCORE has been raised from 75 last year to 80 (not including any targets shot in finals).
