To qualify for High All Around awards athletes must compete in all three American games; American Skeet, Trap and Sporting Clays. Olympic games are individual games. Just for information's sake: In Registered International tournaments, athletes are required to use only 24gram (7/8) ounce ammunition which has a maximum speed up to 1350 fps. This ammunition can be difficult to find, so plan ahead if you plan on using 24gram loads.
